

Gordon Fitzell: Biography

Canadian composer and multimedia artist Gordon Fitzell has worked with diverse ensembles including Norwegian group BIT20 Ensemble, American sextet eighth blackbird, and Brazil's PianOrquestra. His music has been conducted by Robert Aitken, Véronique Lacroix, Reinbert de Leeuw and Bramwell Tovey, and is featured on multiple Grammy-winning, Juno-nominated and West Coast Music Award-nominated recordings. A core member of the Revolution Ensemble, he has also presented sound installations in North America and Europe, and produced a number of recordings for other artists. Fitzell is currently Professor of Composition and Director of the eXperimental Improv Ensemble (XIE) at the University of Manitoba in Winnipeg, where he also serves as Artistic Co-Director of the new music organization GroundSwell. Upcoming performances in 2016 include works at the Pan Music Festival (Seoul) and the Ensemble Mosaik concert series (Berlin).
